Activists share Prop 2 ½ override strategies

On Saturday, May 31st, Sara joined dozens of activists and local leaders for a convening sponsored by ONE Massachusetts and the Public Policy Institute. Inspired by the stories she heard, Sara said, *"I found this to be an incredibly helpful session and it validated my sense that state lawmakers can and should do more to help cities and towns find ways to protect the public structures that make our communities great. An override should be a last resort not the only resort."*
